### The Redding / Shaw Weekly Quiz

#### Week 9

This quiz is being provided on a weekly basis to promote robust crew discussions and further individual rules study. It is in no way intended to be official play interpretations, as those are contained within Part II of the 2019 NCAA Football Rules, and are updated by official CFO Play Interpretation Bulletins when released during the season. These quizzes will be released on Wednesday of each game week, with answers being provided on the following Monday.

Answer each question by giving **THESE FOUR ITEMS** of information for the **next time the ball is to be put in play**:

**Team in possession**

**Down and distance (or Free Kick or Try)**

**Yard line of succeeding spot**

**Game clock status (Ready/ Snap / Running / FK Rules / No Clock / 10-Second Runoff)**

For any fouls that are not offset, assume that the penalty is accepted unless it is declined by rule, including accepting a 10 second subtraction if it is available.

1. A, 4/12, A-25. B23 signals for a fair catch at the 50-yard line but does not touch the ball. While the ball is rolling on the ground, B23 at the B-45 pushes A82 in the back above the waist in an attempt to get to the ball. B80 recovers the ball while grounded at the B-48.

Ruling: **B, 1/10, B-30, snap**

2. A, 4/7, A-40. Team A punts. Receiver B27 is at the B-30 where he signals for a fair catch after the ball has hit the ground. A20 then blocks B27 above the waist, causing B27 to touch the ball. A78 recovers the ball while grounded at the B-32.

Ruling: **B, 1/10, B-32, Snap**

3. A, 1/10, B-25, EXTRA PERIOD. During the first possession series, B45 intercepts a legal forward pass and has a clear path ahead to the goal line. At the A-10 he makes an obscene gesture toward his nearest opponent and then continues across the goal line for a touchdown.

**Ruling: No Score. B, 1/10, A-40, No clock (Penalty enforced at the original 25.)**

4. A, 2/9, A-30. First quarter. At the A-38 runner A23 fumbles the ball which strikes the ground and bounces high into the air. B45 leaps, grabs the ball while he is airborne and returns to the ground touching the sideline at the A-40.

**Ruling: A, 3/1, A-38, Ready**

5. Third and 15 at the B-45. A8's pass is complete to A21 at the B-20. He runs to the B-4, where he is hit and fumbles the ball into and out of the end zone. Prior to the pass, B75 grasped and twisted A66's face mask at the line of scrimmage.

**Ruling: A, 1/Goal, B-2, Snap**

6. With 4<sup>th</sup> and goal at the B-5, A12 throws a pass to the back of the end zone intended for A88. A88 was forced out of the back of the end zone by B21, but A88 immediately gets both feet back inbounds and re-establishes himself in the field of play. A88 then leaps up for the pass gaining possession while airborne and then is hit hard by B21. A88 would have come down inbounds, but the hit by B21 forces him to land out of bounds.

**Ruling: B, 1/10, B-5, Snap**

7. With 2<sup>nd</sup> and 10 at the B-30, QB A12's pass is intercepted by B-21 at the B-4 yard line and his original momentum carries him into the end zone where he is downed. During B-21's run, B45 shoved an opponent in the back above the waist while in the end zone.

**Ruling: B, Free Kick, B-20, F K Rules**

8. While a free kick is in the air, B21 gives a waving signal that does not meet all the requirements of a valid fair catch signal. The ball is subsequently caught by B21 at the B-5.

**Ruling: B, 1/10, B-25, Snap**
