### **Passing Plays**

The next offseason video is now available on the CFO website. This video covers passing plays. When reviewing catch/no catch we must follow this process:

- Establish whether the receiver completed the catch while upright
- Establish firm control
- Establish body part touching the ground
- Establish time element which would include an act common to the game

In addition, we have posted a 10-question quiz on passing plays and the answers to the targeting quiz.

One additional clarification stemming from the National Replay Clinic:

#### **Immediate Continuing Action**

As discussed in Chicago, if the on-field ruling is a runner out of bounds or down and he advances the ball across his opponent's goal line in the immediate continuing action following the ruling, we can award a score in replay if he was not OB/down.

There is no yard line delineation and we must use common sense when making a decision.

This does not apply to a passer being ruled down or out of bounds and then subsequently throwing a pass. That play is not reviewable under any circumstances.
