Game Clock

The third off-season teaching video is available for review. This video covers the game clock. The coaching staffs will also receive a video on this topic. After a call is overturned in replay, it is extremely important that we give the Referee the correct administrative information. This includes the new yard line, down, distance, hash, and clock. Remember the factors we must consider when determining when to reset the game clock:

- If our ruling in replay creates a stopped clock, and time ran off the clock beyond that point, we must reset it. This includes a temporary stoppage (1st down).
- Clock is reset to the point where the play should have ended.
- Clock will start on the ready for play or next snap depending on the result of the review and time remaining in game.
- When time expires at the end of a half the on-field officials must wait for replay to give an all clear before they leave the field. Wing officials should keep both teams in the bench area until replay confirms the half is over.

In addition, we have posted a 10-question quiz pertaining to the game clock, as well as the answers to the quiz on the catch rules.

We will post the answers to the game clock quiz and the next video/quiz in two weeks and continue that schedule up until the start of the season.
