

OFF-SEASON REPLAY QUIZ – GAME ADMINISTRATION

1. Second and 5 on B-30. With 0:10 remaining in the 2nd quarter receiver A80 catches a pass and runs to the B-23 where he is tackled in bounds (0:04). Team A immediately runs its field goal unit onto the field, but the Back Judge recognizes A-88 who was in the game on the previous play with his helmet off and stops the game to have him removed. The Referee holds up play and A-88 leaves the field while Team A gets lined up for a FG attempt. The Referee makes the ball ready for play and winds the clock. The FG attempt is good.

FG good, half over. There is no 10-second runoff for the player without a helmet since that is not the only reason the game clock was stopped. The clock was stopped due to the line to gain being reached. This is an issue for the on-field crew to manage and nothing replay can get involved in. Had the runner been short of the LTG and the helmet off was the only reason the clock was stopped then there would be a runoff and replay should get involved if the on-field officials miss it.

2. Third and 2 on A-38. Back A2 runs around right end and is hit by B96 at the A-36 and fumbles the ball near the sideline. A2 bats the ball to the A-40 where it goes out of bounds. The Line Judge throws her flag and the Referee announces a 10-yard penalty for an illegal bat and repeat of 3rd down.

A 4-12 on A-28, Illegal Bat A2. An illegal bat carries a loss of down and replay should get involved if the crew is going to miss the enforcement. The bat itself is not reviewable. The foul is enforced from the previous spot and it will be 4th down.

3. Third and 10 on 50. QBA1's low pass is intercepted by B32 at the B-40 and returned to the A-20. Replays show that B32 did intercept the pass and after gaining control of the ball his left knee touched the ground. There is a flag down for a facemask on A77 during B32's return.

B 1-10 on A-45, Facemask A77. The defender was down at the spot of the interception and the play is over there, but the personal foul must still be enforced. The clock is also adjusted to where it was when B32 was down. Any foul that occurred after the defender was down other than a personal foul or UNS would be ignored in this situation.

4. Fourth and 10 on A-25. Team A's punt lands at the B-35 and bounces past A22 before it is fielded by B5 at the B-30. B5 runs to the B-40 where he fumbles. A55 recovers and advances the ball across B's goal line. During A55's run, B40 held. The Referee announces that Team A has declined the foul and the ruling on the field is a touchdown. Replays show the ball touching A22's leg at the B-35.

B 1-10 on B-35. The touching of the punt is reviewable and since A touched it first there is an illegal touch violation. The hold by B40 is declined by rule and Team B gets the ball at the illegal touch spot.

5. Second and 8 on B-43. With 0:05 remaining in the 2nd quarter QBA1's Hail Pass falls incomplete in the end zone as time expires. A77 is called for holding during the down and the Referee announces that the half is over.

Half over. If Team B declines the foul (which they will) the half is over. If Team B accepts the penalty, the half is extended. Important that we listen to the Referee's announcement on all penalties to ensure we have all the correct information.

6. Third and 7 on A-33. QBA1's low pass is ruled intercepted by B41 at the A-45. B41 returns it to the A-30 where he is tackled. During the return B77 blocked A79 low at the A-40. Replays show the ball hit the ground before B41 controlled it. Team A had five players in the backfield at the snap.

A 1-10 on A-43, adjust clock. As it was ruled on the field Team B can keep the ball because its foul occurred after they gained possession. Since the ball hit the ground before B41 gained control the pass is incomplete. Team B's foul is a personal foul, so it must be enforced, and it is enforced as a dead ball foul. After the reversal we have a live ball foul and a dead ball foul which are enforced separately and in the order of their occurrence. Five yards from the previous spot for Team A's illegal formation and 15 from that spot with an automatic first down for B's low block.

7. Third and 12 on A-28. With 0:55 remaining in the 4th quarter Team A leads 20-17 and Team B is out of timeouts. Back A2 runs up the middle and is tackled at the A-30 (0:50). B77 is injured on the play and the officials stop the game clock. B77 leaves the game and the Referee announces a ten second runoff and resets the play clock to 25 seconds.

A 4-10 on A-30, 0:50 on clock and then run 10, play clock to 0:40 and wind. After a Team B injury inside one minute that stops the clock the play clock is reset to 40. Obviously, this is critical in this situation and replay should stop the game to adjust.

8. First and 10 on A-25. Back A2 takes a pitch and runs near the sideline to the B-45 where he is hit by B41 and loses the ball. The Side Judge rules that A2 stepped out of bounds before the ball came loose and has a flag down for a late hit out of bounds on B41. Replays show the ball came loose before A2 touched the sideline and it was clearly recovered in bounds by B7 at the B-40.

A 1-10 on B-30. Whether the runner stepped out or fumbled prior to that the enforcement of the penalty will be the same so no reason to stop the game here. The foul is enforced from either the dead ball spot if he stepped out or the end of the run if he didn't which in this situation are the same. Without the foul replay can make this a fumble and give the ball to Team B at the spot of the clear recovery.

9. Fourth and 14 on A-26. Team A's punt is partially blocked and bounces to the A-40 where it is recovered by A22. The officials rule that the ball hit B30 on the leg before A22 recovered. There is a flag down for holding on B17 while the ball was loose. Replays show the ball did not touch B30.

B 1-10 on 50. Whether B30 touched the ball or not is reviewable and since he did not Team B will get the ball. The foul is enforced from the end of the kick (postscrimmage kick spot) because the ball crossed the neutral zone, foul occurred during the kick, and Team B will next put the ball in play.

10. Third and Goal on B-5. Receiver A80 catches a pass near the goal line and is tackled immediately after which A77 knocks B98 to the ground behind the play. The officials rule TD. Replays show the ball was at the $\frac{1}{2}$ yard line when A80's right knee was down.

A 4-Goal on B-15 $\frac{1}{2}$. The ball in relation to the goal line is reviewable and here the ball is short when the runner was down. The dead ball foul is enforced from the new dead ball spot which is the $\frac{1}{2}$ yard line and it will be 4th and goal.
